I am a qualified nurse who supports the pupils and staff. I can help you if you have a health condition such as asthma, epilepsy and diabetes so that you can continue to attend school.

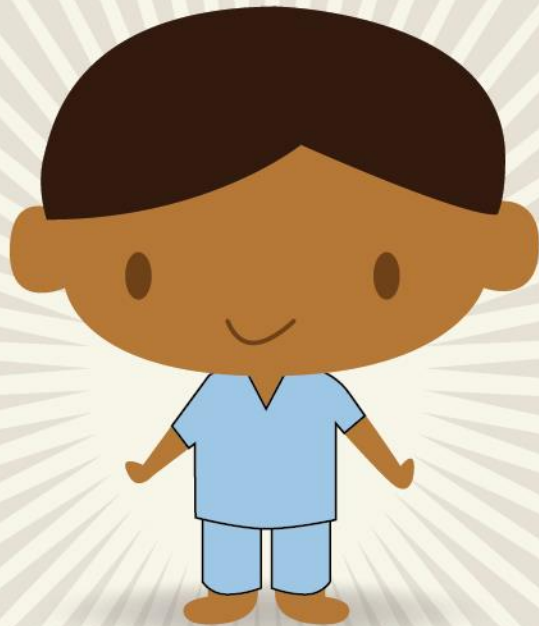
I will support you with issues such as healthy eating, emotional health, sleep issues and difficult family circumstances.

Universal

- Some children and young people need extra help from an expert . The School Nursing Service can give a quick response when you need it most.

Universal Partnership Plus

- For young people who have more complex issues the School Nurse service provides on-going help by working with lots of different organisations such as a nearby charity or council.

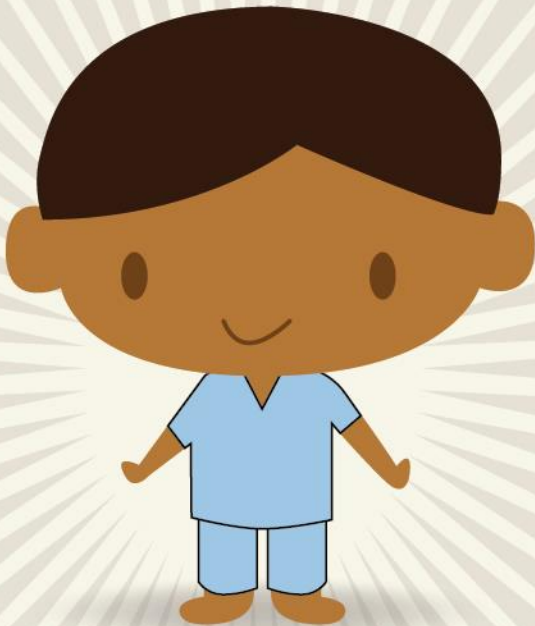
What Services Do We Provide?



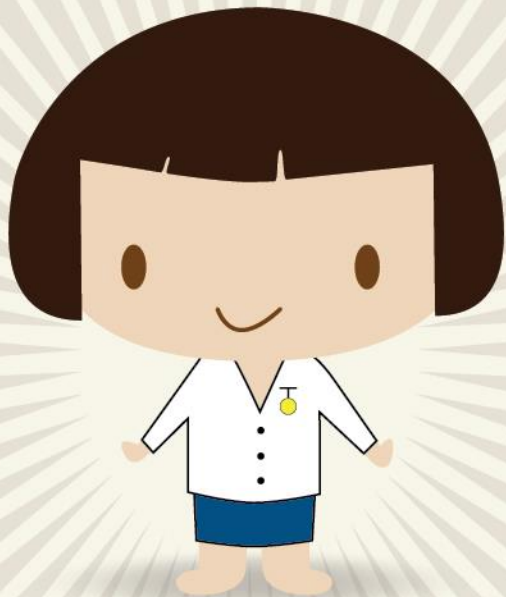
- One to One appointments with a qualified nurse every week or other times if needed.
- HPV vaccinations to Year 8 girls.
- Updates for staff for any pupil with a complex health need.
- Support with emotional health, stress, family difficulties.
