Navy Blazer with school badge

Straight Black Trousers, classically pleated front, traditional fit
or **girls: knee length Maroon skirt**

V-Necked Maroon Jumper with school colours on the neck
or **girls: Maroon Cardigan** with school colours on the neck

Formal White Shirt to be worn, tucked in, with **House** clip-on tie

Black **shoes**; white, grey or black **socks**
or **girls: black or opaque tights**

A sensible coat (no hoodies or sweatshirts).



PE lessons (boys)

- Reversible rugby shirt – maroon/navy.
- White 'aertex' t-shirt.
- Maroon shorts.
- Maroon and navy socks with gold stripes.
- Trainers (not with black soles).
- Football boots (rubber or aluminium studs).

Shin pads for soccer (**these are now required by law**).

Mouth guard – required for rugby and hockey.

Optional – black or blue tracksuit bottoms – straight leg, no cuff, no zips.

PE lessons (girls)

- Reversible rugby shirt – maroon/navy.
- Pale blue 'aertex' t-shirt.
- Maroon shorts.
- Maroon and navy socks with gold stripes.
- Trainers (not with black soles).
- Football boots (rubber or aluminium studs).

Shin pads for soccer (**these are now required by law**).

Mouth guard – required for hockey.

Optional – black or blue tracksuit bottoms – straight leg, no cuff, no zips.

All uniform can be purchased from our official supplier 'Rumors' on Victoria Road.

All items of uniform and outdoor clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name.

uniform and appearance

Graham School students wear their uniform with pride. Our uniform shows that we are part of the Graham School community. We have the highest expectations from our students with regard to school uniform and appearance and we strongly believe that our high expectations promote positive behaviour, support effective teaching and learning and contribute to the ethos of the school.

General notes on appearance:

- Clip on ties should be worn appropriately with the metal clip through the top button hole and with the top button fastened.
- Shirts should be tucked in at all times.

Jewellery:

- The wearing of jewellery in school is strictly limited as follows:
- ONE pair of discreet studs may be worn. NYCC policy states that earrings must be removed for PE lessons for health and safety reasons.
- No other piercings of any kind are allowed.

Hairstyles:

- Hair should be one natural colour.
- The style should be appropriate for school.
- Boys' hair should be no shorter than Grade 2.
- Tramlines, patterns and sculpting is not allowed.

Students must not wear:

- Hoodies, sportswear or sweatshirts.
- Any kind of boots (wellingtons are allowed in wet weather/snow but must be changed when inside the school buildings).
- Any jumper or cardigan other than the official Graham School jumper/cardigan.
- Coloured tee-shirts or undergarments containing lettering or patterns which may be visible through the shirt.
- Leather or denim clothing.
- Trainers are NOT allowed to be worn at any time other than for PE lessons and clubs.
- Make up and nail varnish should NOT be worn to school.
